The International Nutrition Survey 2014 is 3 months away!

Registration will open online in August or September 2014

Survey Timelines

There are two timeline options for INS 2014 depending on a) if you are a burn unit and b) if your site would like to be eligible for the Best of the Best Award, as illustrated below. All sites must finalize a minimum of 15 patients to receive a site report.

Timelines for burn units as well as any site who would like to be eligible for the Best of the Best Award To be eligible for the Best of the Best Award sites must finalize data on 20 patients.

Start collecting data

September 17th 2014

All data must be entered into data capture system plus 60 data outcomes and data must be cleaned



February 15th 2015 Eligible for Best of the Best

Timelines for non-burn units

Start collecting data

All data must be entered into data capture system plus 60 data outcomes and data must be cleaned



September 17th 2014 to January 15th 2015

February 15th 2015 to June 1st 2015 **NOT** eligible for Best of the Best

Sites may begin collecting data before September 17th as long as:

- > patients are enrolled consecutively (record patients screened on the Screening Log Case Report Form).
- > head of the bed elevation is recorded on the Screening Log when a patient is enrolled in the survey.
- > data is collected on the paper Case Report Forms or you can wait until September to enter data electronically.
- > data is entered in the electronic data capture system after September 17th 2014.

PEP uP Collaborative sites who have not implemented the protocol or are not ready to audit their site by September 17th, 2014 can follow the timelines for non burn-units (as illustrated above).

The final Instruction and Case Report Forms for <u>burn units</u> and <u>non-bur</u>n units are available!
