

Serious Adverse Event Reporting: A Few Reminders

For an adverse event to be reported to the Methods Centre is must be **serious and unexpected**.

Defining Serious

Any untoward medical occurrence that at any dose:

- ◆ Results in death
- ◆ Is life-threatening
- ◆ Requires in patient hospitalization or prolongation of existing hospitalization
- ◆ Results in persistent or significant disability/incapacity
- ◆ Is a congenital anomaly or birth defect
- ◆ Other medically important condition

Defining Unexpected


For the purposes of the REDOXS© Study, given the population of critically ill patients with organ dysfunction, an unexpected SAE is defined as an event that is serious and is **NOT expected due to the progression of the underlying disease or co-morbid illnesses**.

Please note: Deaths related to the progression of underlying illness are NOT considered unexpected & do NOT need to be reported.

All unexpected SAEs **must be** reported to the Methods Centre **within 24 hours** of becoming aware of the event.
Always contact the Project Leader if you have questions regarding whether an event should be reported.


